

## MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

THIS MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING ("MoU") is made on the 19 day of April, Two thousand and twenty three ([19/04/2023]), BY AND BETWEEN:

**SCHOOL OF MEANINGFUL EXPERIENCES PRIVATE LIMITED**, a company incorporated under the Companies Act, 2013, having its registered office at No. 681, 10<sup>th</sup> Main, 4<sup>th</sup> B Cross, Koramangala 4<sup>th</sup> Block, Bangalore – 560 034, (hereinafter referred to as "**SoME**", which expression shall, unless repugnant to the context, include its successors and permitted assigns), of the ONE PART;

AND

**K. S. School of Engineering and Management**, #15, Mallasandra, off Kanakapura Road, Bengaluru

(hereinafter referred to as "**Partner College**", which expression shall, unless repugnant to the context include its successors and permitted assigns), of the OTHER PART.

SoME and the Partner College may be individually referred to as a "**Party**" and together as "**Parties**".

### WHEREAS:

1. SoME is *inter alia* engaged in the business of human skills training and education;
2. The Partner College is an educational institution whose students will participate in the SoMEvaadam community;
3. Pursuant to discussions between the Parties, the Parties have agreed to enter into a mutually beneficial arrangement the terms and conditions of which the Parties wish to record by entering into this MoU.

1. SCOPE OF THE MoU	1.1 The Parties wish to come together to create a community called SoMEvaadam for students of the Partner College to help them improve their communication and human skills ("Purpose").  1.2 The first SoMEvaadam community shall consist of 20 (twenty) students selected from the student body of the Partner College. Of the 20 (twenty) students, 3 (Three) students shall be identified and selected to become campus ambassadors based on specified criteria decided in consultation between SoME and the Partner College.
2. OBLIGATIONS OF THE PARTNER COLLEGE	2.1 The Partner College shall undertake the following obligations:

	<p>2.1.1 The Partner College shall recognise and approve the creation and operation of the SoMEVaadam community, and promote the same across its student community;</p> <p>2.1.2 The Partner College shall allocate space for the SoMEVaadam community to meet and practice communication one hour a week outside academic hours;</p> <p>2.1.3 The Partner College shall identify and appoint one faculty member to anchor the initiative and moderate the SoMEVaadam community in association with SoME ("Faculty Mentor");</p> <p>2.1.4 The Faculty Mentor shall work together with SoME and shall participate in and approve the selection of the campus ambassadors in consultation with SoME;</p>
<p>3. OBLIGATIONS of SoME</p>	<p>3.1 SoME shall undertake the following obligations:</p> <p>3.1.1 SoME will provide exclusive training programmes to the campus ambassadors for a period of 4 (four) weeks.</p> <p>3.1.2 SoME will also provide kits for the programme and the SoMEVaadam community, which will contain an operating manual that will have guidelines of the community, rules and regulations, attendance records, a monthly webinar facility with the guides of SoME and token memento for the community; and</p> <p>3.1.3 SoME will also recognise the Partner College and the campus ambassadors on social media.</p>
<p>4. ROLE OF THE STUDENT COMMUNITY</p>	<p>4.1 The students forming part of the SoMEVaadam community shall undertake the following initiatives:</p> <p>4.1.1. The campus ambassadors will ensure one meeting every week with the community. In this meeting, the campus ambassadors will follow the guidelines mentioned in the operating manual and undertake the activities set out therein, in consultation with the Faculty Mentor and SoME;</p> <p>4.1.2. The campus ambassadors shall collect attendance records, photographs and other documentation associated with the SoMEVaadam community and will upload the same on the SoME portal/Nodal point.</p>

	<p>4.1.3. The SoMEVaadam community, led by the campus ambassadors will conduct a monthly webinar with SoME guides and the Faculty Mentor;</p> <p>4.1.4. The SoMEVaadam community, led by the campus ambassadors will help in organising Intra and Inter college competitions; and</p> <p>4.1.5. The campus ambassadors will train the other community members to make them proficient in communication and human skills.</p>
<p><b>5. TERM &amp; TERMINATION</b></p>	<p>5.1 This MoU shall be effective as of [19.04.2023] and shall be valid for a period of 5 (five) years from the effective date.</p> <p>5.2 This MOU shall commence as set forth above and remain in effect through the end of the term unless:</p> <p>5.2.1 Otherwise superseded by another MOU between the parties.</p> <p>5.2.2 The parties mutually agree to terminate this MOU.</p> <p>5.2.3 Either party gives the other 45 days' written notice of their intent to terminate this MOU.</p> <p>5.2.4 A breaching party has failed to cure a material breach of this MOU within 30 days following written notice of that breach given by the non-breaching party.</p>
<p><b>6. CONFIDENTIALITY</b></p>	<p>6.1 Each party shall treat all data and information including all community material and documentation disclosed to it or which comes into its possession or knowledge in connection with this MoU as confidential and shall not disclose the same to any third parties, without the prior consent of the other party.</p> <p>6.2 Each Party shall further, not misuse information and data received from the other party for its own gains without the prior consent of the other party.</p>
<p><b>7. GOVERNING LAW AND JURISDICTION</b></p>	<p>7.1 This MoU shall be governed by the laws of India and subject to the above, the courts in Bangalore shall have exclusive jurisdiction.</p>

This MoU shall be binding on the Parties.

This MoU supersedes any previous oral discussions or understandings the Parties may have had regarding the subject matter hereof and the arrangements contemplated herein.

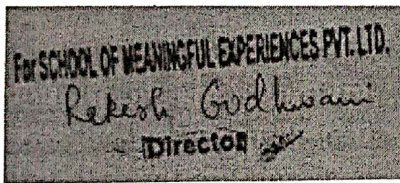
