In final round of competition participants were categorized based on topics selected in their first round held on 7<sup>th</sup> November 2024. Here's a breakdown:

- Total final Participants: 19
- Categories:
  - Current Affairs: 5 participants
  - Automobile: 7 participants
  - World Cinema: 7 participants

### **Contest Format:**

**Round 3 (Hard):** The final round before the Extreme phase consisted of 7 challenging questions. At this point, only the most knowledgeable participants remained, and the competitions for the top spots became intense.

After hard round, a number of contestants eliminated based on their performance. This elimination process continued until only three contestants remained, who then proceeded to the Extreme Round.

### **Extreme Round**

The Extreme Round was the final stage of the competition, where the three finalists competed in a series of 10 tough questions. The stakes were high, as each question in this round had a prize money attached, rewarding the contestants for their performance and perseverance throughout the competition.

To help the contestants in difficult moments, they were provided with a lifeline in the form of Expert Advice. This lifeline allowed participants to seek help from a subject matter expert for a specific question, which portrayed as a game-changer in such a high-stakes environment.

In the face-off round, **Pavan S** from the 7th Semester, ECE Department, won ₹500 in the Current Affairs category, while **Subhash S.S** from the 5<sup>th</sup> Semester, AI&DS Department, triumphed with ₹1000 in the Automobile category.

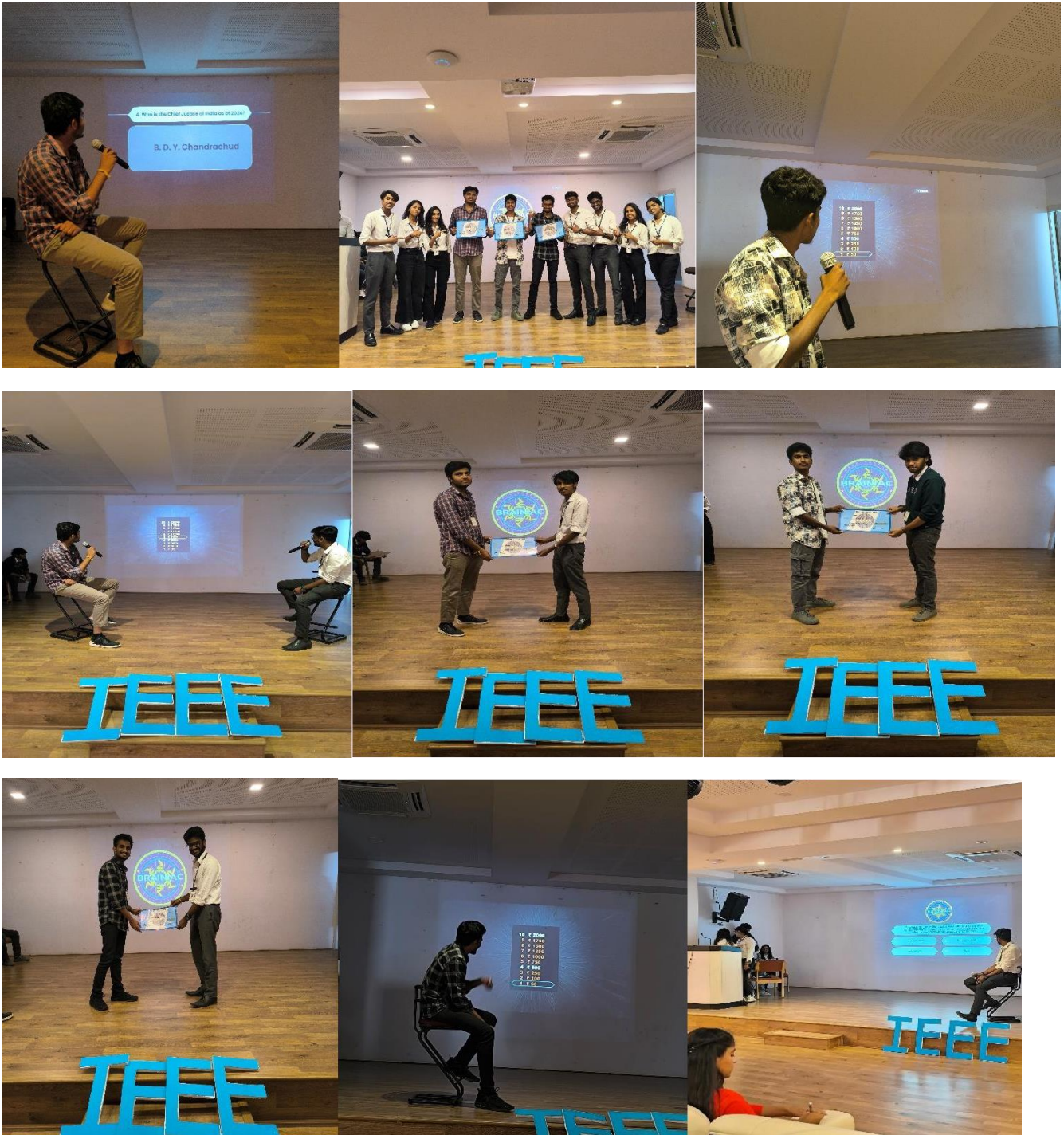
