General guidelines were shared with the students –


- * The internship shall be compulsory for all the students.

- * Students to submit one hard copy of the report to the college with a hard bound color of royal blue and a soft copy in PDF file (Un-editable Format).
- * Evaluation will be done by both internal and external guide, carrying 40-60marks which carries marks for the report, viva-voce. Rubrics for internship was also discussed.
- * Information about Content Cover page, Certificate from the Organization (scanned copy), Certificate from the college, Declaration by the student, Acknowledgement, Table of contents, list of tables and graphs, preparing an Internship Report.
- * Summary Introduction about the Organization & Industry, Organization Profile, Mckensy's 7S framework and Porter's Five Force Model with special reference to Organization, SWOT Analysis, Analysis of financial statements, Learning experience.

PROCTORSHIP



The workshop on "Usage of Statistical tools for Data Analysis" was conducted for 3rd Sem MBA students and for all faculty members of MBA. 32 students and 7 faculty members participated in the session. Introduction about the session and Welcome speech was given by Ms. Nishchitha R Gowda.

Profile of the Guest speaker was read by Ms. Monika V.

The session was started by enquiring the specialization chosen by students and the resource person stressed on having a broader perspective of the title for the project/ freelance project. Students are asked to download 5 papers related to the topics finalized. Once after downloading the Empirical papers, Dr. Tamizharasi guided students to how to identify the variables and write the Review of Literature. Students were asked to identify the variables and write Literature Review of 1 paper. It was verified by the resource person and correction was done wherever it was necessary.

The resource person also briefed on how to collect the data and prepare the questionnaire. Sample data was shared with students to show analysis using SPSS. The various statistical

tools used were t- test, paired t - test, Z- test, Chi square, ANOVA, MANOVA were shown and

Hands-on session was given to students to gain broader perspective of the project and also inputs were given to convert Empirical project into Research paper for Journal publication.



The event gave glimpses on Library usage with E-tools. E-learning tools are constantly changing and updating, which means the tools in this guide will also be changing and updating. Technology is changing the way we do nearly everything, from driving our cars to experiencing (virtual) reality, right down to the way we learn and teach. Our new Continuum column dives into the e-learning waters by addressing a spectrum of issues including the nature of e-learning, the role of technologically-informed teaching and learning in library work, and the resources that are needed to make e-learning happen. One of the most important things to understand about e-learning is that it is not just one thing. It has many dimensions and applications and can be used in many different ways, from supporting teaching and learning in the classroom to providing fully online distance education. E-learning is best viewed as part of a teaching and learning continuum that begins with face-to-face teaching without the use of information and communication technologies (ICT) at one end and fully online distance learning at the other end. As we move along the continuum from fully face-to-face teaching, technology is used to replace the face-to-face elements. Initially, this has very little impact on how teaching is organized and how learning occurs because the technology is used primarily to enhance the face-to-face teaching. But as we move further along the continuum, the nature of teaching and how it is organized is

increasingly affected by the use of ICT. Somewhere around the middle of the continuum we

have what is called blended learning or the "flipped" classroom. In a blended environment, fewer face-to-face sessions are held as technology is used increasingly to deliver the teaching and to facilitate the learning. And nature of the face-to-face sessions changes. Instead of coming to class to listen to a teacher, students come to discuss, and to work and collaborate in small groups. Once we reach the right end of the continuum there is no longer any face-to-face teaching and we have fully online learning in which all teaching is technology-mediated. E-learning is that part of the continuum that begins when technology is used to replace some of the face-to-face teaching to the point on the continuum where it replaces it all.

"Through this Speech, I want to tell Students & people that making change is possible. Especially to youngsters who want to be the change to the country. "—Anirudh Dutt

He told, a bunch of students decided to do something for the city, "we asked around—most of the people told us that waste management was a bane, so we decided to something about it and That was how LBTC began." LBTC stands for "Let's Be the Change"; yes, an apt name.

In a time when most organizations fail and crumble, LBTC has grown from strength to strength, with as many as ten to twelve volunteers in the beginning, to cleaning and beautifying the walls of the entire bus station of Majestic/ Kempegowda Bus terminus, organizing a cleaning drive at more than 160 wards in the city and recently the Plog run that involved more people in the quest to make Bengaluru plastic free.

LBTC at its core is backed by a strong interface with the local wards, health officers, Pourakarmikas and the corporators at the helm. Anirudh informed me over the course of the conversation, that there are a paltry 50-60 personnel per ward to manage the waste that is contributed over by over 60,000 residents. Just imagine for once the gravity of the situation.

While LBTC's bread and butter work has been cleaning black spots in the city that are hot spots for garbage dumps by beautifying the place, they also have taken to raising the voice and informing people of the need for segregation of waste and recycling of materials. They firmly believe in the philosophy of sharing their knowledge and are constantly on the quest to enable youth leaders in every ward, by helping them connect with the ward leaders. This decentralization of responsibility has always long-term sustainable benefits too...

Overall, if you are hearing this and thinking of that one idea that you think can make the world a better place, "Go ahead and give it your time and effort and the changes shall follow".

Typically, hypothesis testing utilizes two different types of hypothesis: the null hypothesis and the alternative hypothesis. The null hypothesis represents the assumption that is made about the data sample, whereas the alternative hypothesis represents a counterpoint. More often than not, the alternative hypothesis takes the exact opposite point of view from the null hypothesis. Hypothesis testing is used in statistics to learn about and understand different population groups. Additionally, the results of hypothesis testing can sometimes be used to predict the likelihood of future outcomes within the population group. By going through the process of testing a hypothesis, scientists and mathematicians are able to determine the statistical validity of their inferences, which helps them to learn about the world around us.

The workshop on "Application of Statistical tools in Business Management" was conducted for IV Sem MBA students and for all faculty members of MBA. 28 students and 6 faculty members participated in the session. Introduction about the session, Welcome speech and Guest speaker Profile was presented by Ms. Kruthika.

The session was started giving broader idea of Hypothesis, it's types, Variables, statistical tools, and in detail by resource person Dr. Tamizharasi. Madam also guided students to how to identify the variables. Students were asked to identify the variables.

Individual reports were verified by the resource person and correction was done wherever it was necessary. Guided students to collect Sample data was shared with students to show analysis using SPSS. The various statistical techniques like t- test, paired t - test, Z- test, Chi square, ANOVA, MANOVA were introduced and shown how to perform using SPSS software. 


We have provide 8 balloons they have to prepare any character with in it . by using this things more creative mind, skills and innovative ideas are required.


3. BALLOON GAME:



5. Plate walk:


