1.0 Introduction:

A Proposal Writing Workshop was conducted for the faculty members of KS Group of Institutions. The program aimed to enhance the skills and knowledge of participants in writing effective FDP proposals for funding from various agencies. The workshop was divided into three sessions, conducted by Dr. Swamy D R, Executive Director of KSRIF, and coordinated by Dr. P N Jyothi, Professor, Mechanical Department, KSSEM. The participants included 11 faculty members from the Mechanical Engineering and Electronics and Communication departments of KSSEM and KSIT.

Session 1: Understanding the Basics of Proposal Writing

The first session of the workshop focused on providing participants with a comprehensive understanding of the basics of proposal writing. Dr. Swamy D R discussed the importance of clear objectives, problem statements, and methodology in a research proposal. He emphasized the significance of aligning the proposal with the objectives of funding agencies and highlighted the need for a convincing argument for the significance and originality of the research.

Session 2: Structure and Content of FDP Proposals

In the second session, Dr. Swamy D R delved into the structure and content of research proposals. He discussed the various sections that should be included in a proposal, such as the introduction, literature review, objectives, methodology, timeline, and budget. The participants were provided with practical tips for structuring their proposals effectively and enhancing the overall readability and coherence.

Session 3: Proposal Evaluation

The final session focused on the evaluation criteria used by funding agencies to assess research proposals. Dr. Swamy D R guided the participants on understanding the key factors considered during the evaluation process, such as feasibility, relevance, and

potential impact. He also emphasized the importance of ethical considerations in research proposals and guided the participants on incorporating appropriate ethical practices and guidelines.

The Proposal Writing Workshop conducted for the faculty members of KS Group of Institutions was a valuable initiative to enhance the proposal writing skills of the faculty members. The program provided participants with a comprehensive understanding of the basics of proposal writing, as well as practical strategies for structuring and evaluating research proposals effectively. It is expected that this workshop will contribute to the overall improvement of grant applications and increase the success rate of obtaining funding for FDP proposal conducted by the faculty members of KS Group of Institutions.
