Immunization requirements:

In accordance with New York State Public Health Law, UB requires that all students (undergraduate, graduate, professional) born on or after January 1, 1957 provide proof of immunity against measles, mumps, and rubella. The state also requires that all students receive information about meningococcal disease and have made an informed decision about whether or not to receive immunization against meningococcal disease. Additional requirements for International applicants:

Upon final approval of your credentials in the Office of International Admissions, your I-20, along with information on housing and other appropriate items, will be sent to you directly from the Office of International Admissions. This process will take approximately one month after you have notified us of your acceptance of our offer; please note your application will not be forwarded to International Admissions until we receive your response.
