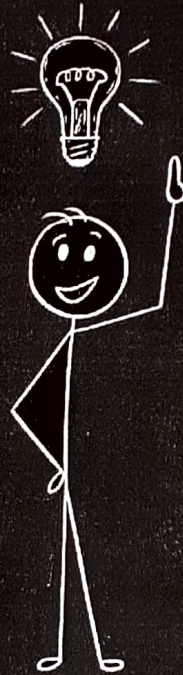

## Idea Club

A well-structured and visually appealing presentation can make a significance in conveying your project proposal / project idea effectively. Here are some step-by-step instructions for the PPT presentation format for a project proposal.

### Instructions for PPT presentation

1. The PowerPoint presentation must be limited to a maximum of 10 slides.
2. The presentation should cover the following key elements:
  - a. Organization name with logo, Title of the project, Student name, Guide name, Team number, and the date.
  - b. Briefly introduce the project and its importance.
  - c. Aim / Problem statement.
  - d. Objectives: List the specific objectives of the project.
  - e. Methodology / approach: Existing method and the improvement in the method.
  - f. Videos and sketches can be employed in the PowerPoint presentation to provide a more effective explanation.
  - g. Avoid adding text animation.
  - h. Facilities available and required, both in terms of hardware and software.
  - i. Project Timeline: Provide a visual timeline.
  - j. Budget: Break down the estimated project budget.
  - k. Funding Request: If applicable, state how much funding is needed and explain how the funds will be used.
